new zealand sector of antarctica it lists 65 species including native and exotic wild and feral living and extinct residents vagrants and failed introductions it describes their history biology and ecology and brings together comprehensive and detailed information gathered from widely scattered or previously unpublished sources the description of each species is arranged under standardised headings for easy reference because the only native land breeding mammals in new zealand are bats and seals the great majority of the modern mammal fauna comprises introduced species whose arrival has had profound effects both for themselves and for the native fauna and flora the book details changes in numbers and distribution for the native species and for the arrivals it summarises changes in habitat diet numbers and size in comparison with their ancestral stocks and some of the problems they present to resource managers for this third edition the text and references have been completely updated and reorganised into family chapters the colour section includes 14 pages of artwork showing all the species described and their main variations plus two pages of maps

it is generally forgotten that cricket rather than rugby union was the national game in new zealand until the early years of the twentieth century this book shows why and how cricket developed in new zealand and how its character changed across time greg ryan examines the emergence and growth of cricket in relation to diverse patterns of european settlement in new zealand such as the systematic colonization schemes of edward gibbon wakefield and the gold discoveries of the 1860s he then considers issues such as cricket and social class in the emerging cities cricket and the elite school system the function of the game in shaping relations between the new zealand provinces cricket encounters with the australian colonies in the context of an australasian world a central theme is cricketing relations with england at a time when new zealand society was becoming acutely conscious of both its own identity and its place within the british empire this imperial relationship reveals structures ideals and objectives unique to new zealand articulate engaging and entertaining ryan demonstrates convincingly how the cricketing experience of new zealand was quite different from that of other colonies

in the late nineteenth century on the eve of the formation of australia as a nation state in 1902 the australian medical system could be best described as a pluralistic one in the sense that while regular medicine constituted the predominant medical system it was not clearly the dominant one in that regular physicians faced competition from a wide array of alternative practitioners as regular medicine increasingly assumed the guise of being scientific it evolved into biomedicine and developed a link with corporate and state interests in the early twentieth century in australia as in other capitalist developed societies relying upon state support australian biomedicine has achieved dominance over alternative medical system such as homeopathy herbal medicine osteopathy chiropractic and naturopathy various social forces particularly the development of the holistic health movement have served to challenge biomedical dominance in australia like elsewhere what started out as a popular health movement in the early 1970s has evolved into the professionalized entity that is generally referred to as complementary medicine in australia as opposed to complementary and alternative medicine in the us and uk complementary

medicine in australia encompasses many medical systems and therapies since the 1980s certain heterodox medical systems particularly chiropractic osteopathy acupuncture and chinese medicine naturopathy western herbalism and homeopathy have achieved considerable recognition from the australian state either at the federal level or at the state and territorial levels indeed the australian state appears to have gone further than any other anglophone country in terms of providing public funding for complementary medicine education conversely it has committed a limited amount of funding for complementary medicine research compared to the united states

since the early 2000s new zealand has undergone a pop renaissance domestic artists sales airplay and concert attendance have all grown dramatically while new avenues for kiwi pop exports emerged concurrent with these trends was a new collective sentiment that embraced and celebrated domestic musicians in making new zealand s pop renaissance michael scott argues that this revival arose from state policies and shows how the state built market opportunities for popular musicians through public private partnerships and organizational affinity with existing music industry institutions new zealand offers an instructive case for the ways in which after neo liberal states steer and co ordinate popular culture into market exchange by incentivizing cultural production scott highlights how these music policies were intended to address various economic and social problems arriving with the creative industries discourse and policy making politicians claimed these expanded popular music supports would facilitate sustainable employment and a sense of national identity yet popular music as economic and social policy presents a paradox the music industry generates commercial failure and thus requires a large unattached pool of potential talent considering this feature scott analyses how state programs induced an informal economy of proto pop production aimed at accessing competitive state funding while simultaneously encouraging musicians to adopt entrepreneurial subjectivities in doing so he argues new zealand s music policies are a form of social policy that unintentionally deploy hierarchical structures to foster social inclusion amongst growing numbers of creative workers

the seismic design actions and associated criteria of each code for areas of different seismicity and for structures with different ductility properties requirements a third section devoted to the capacity side which describes the capacities of members and joints and associated criteria of each code including member strengths in flexure shear and bars anchorage desirable hierarchies of strength attainment deformation capacities of mechanisms of inelastic deformation detailing of beams columns and structural walls detailing of beam column joints for shear and the detailing of diaphragms the second chapter is devoted to the comparison of the more significant issues dealt in the considered codes this includes seismic design actions and associated criteria capacity design practice beams columns confinement structural walls and joints it is felt that fib bulletin 69 represents a useful unique instrument for rapidly gaining an overview of the distinguishing features of the major world codes under both their conceptual framework and application rules
