through detailed close readings alongside investigations into the history of print culture marta fossati traces the development of the south african short story in english from the late 1920s to the first decade of the twenty first century she examines a selection of short stories by important black south african writers rolfes and herbert dhlomo peter abrahams can themba alex la guma mtutuzeli matshoba ahmed essop and zoë wicomb with an alertness to the dialogue between ethics and aesthetics performed by these texts this new history of black short fiction problematises and interrogates the often polarised readings of black literature in south africa that can be torn between notions of literariness protest and journalism due to material constraints short fiction in south africa circulated first and foremost through local print media which fossati analyses in detail to show the cross fertilisation between journalism and the short story while rooted in the south african context the short stories considered also hold a translocal dimension allowing us to explore the ethical and aesthetic practice of intertextuality these are writings that complicate the aesthetics ethics binary generic classifications and the categories of the literary and the political theoretically eclectic in its approach although largely underpinned by a narratological analysis the south african short story in english 1920 2010 when aesthetics meets ethics offers a fresh perspective on the south african short story in english spotlighting several hitherto marginalised figures in south african literary studies

in 2013 the nobel prize for literature was for the first time awarded to a short story writer and to a canadian alice munro the award focused international attention on a genre that had long been thriving in canada particularly since the 1960s this book traces the development and highlights of the english language canadian short story from the late 19th century up to the present the history as

sound effects combines literary criticism and psychoanalytic theory in eleven original articles which explore the potential of the object voice as an analytic tool to approach fiction alongside the gaze the voice is jacques lacan s original addition to the set of partial objects of classical psychoanalysis and has only recently been theorised by mladen dolar in a voice and nothing more 2006 with

western fans today may not recognize the name ernest haycox 1899 1950 but they know his work john ford turned one of his stories into the iconic film stagecoach and the whole western literary genre still follows conventions that haycox deftly mastered and reshaped in this new book about haycox s literary career richard w etulain tells the engrossing story of his rise through the ranks of popular magazine and serial fiction to become one of the western s most successful creators after graduating from the university of oregon in 1923 with a degree in journalism haycox began his quest to break into new york s pulp magazine scene submitting dozens of stories before he began to make a living from his writing by the end of the 1920s he had become a top writer for western story short stories and adventure among other popular weeklies and monthlies ernest haycox and the western traces haycox s path from rank beginner to crack pulp writer to regular contributor to collier s and the saturday evening post etulain shows how haycox experimented with techniques to deepen and broaden his westerns creating more introspective protagonists hamlet heroes introducing new types of heroines the brunette vixen the blonde puritan and weaving greater historical realism into his plots after reaching the height of success with his best selling custer novel bugles in the afternoon 1944 haycox moved away from the financially rewarding but artistically constricting western formula only to achieve his final coup with the earthbreakers a historical novel about the end of the oregon trail published posthumously in 1952 reconstructing the career of a popular literary giant ernest haycox and the western restores haycox to his rightful place in the history of western literature

even well meaning fiction writers of the late jim crow era 1900 1955 perpetuated racial stereotypes in their depiction of black characters from 1918 to 1952 octavus roy cohen turned out a remarkable 360 short stories featuring florian slappey and the schemers romancers and ditzes of birmingham's darktown for the saturday evening post and other publications cohen said i received a great deal of mail from negroes and i have never found any resentment from a one of them the black readership had to be satisfied with any black presence in the popular literature of the day the best known white writers of black characters included booth tarkington herman and verman in the penrod books irvin s cobb judge priest s houseman jeff poindexter roark bradford widow duck the plantation matriarch hugh wiley wildcat marsden the war veteran who traveled the country in the company of his goat and charles correll and freeman gosden radio s amos n andy these writers deservedly declined in the civil rights era but left a curious legacy that deserves examination this book focusing on authors of series fiction and particularly of humorous stories profiles 29 writers and their black characters in detail with brief entries covering 72 others

the last decades have seen a revival of fragmentation in british and american works of fiction that deny linearity coherence and continuity in favour of disruption gaps and fissures authors such as ali smith david mitchell and david shields have sought new ways of representing our global media saturated contemporary experience which differ from modernist and postmodernist experimentations from which the writers nevertheless draw inspiration this volume aims to investigate some of the most important contributions to fragmentary literature from british and american writers since the 1990s with a particular emphasis on texts released in the twenty first century the chapters within examine whether contemporary forms of literary fragmentation constitute a return to the modernist episteme or the fragmented literature of exhaustion of the 1960s mark a continuity with postmodernist aesthetics or signal a deviation from past models and an attempt to reflect today's accelerated culture of social media and over communication contributors theorise and classify literary fragments examine the relationship between fragmentation and the zeitgeist influenced by globalisation media saturation and social networks analyse the mechanics of multimodal and multimedial fictions and consider the capacity of literary fragmentation to represent personal or collective trauma and to address ethical concerns they also investigate the ways in which the architecture of the printed book is destabilised and how aesthetic processes involving fragmentation bricolage and

or collage raise ontological ethical and epistemological questions about the globalised contemporary world we live in and its relation to the self and the other besides the aforementioned authors the volume makes reference to the works of j g ballard julian barnes mark z danielewski david markson jonathan safran foer david foster wallace jeanette winterson and several others
