sees america as essentially christian making his case for the nation s crucial faith component while exploring varied interpretations of comments like one made in 2009 by president barack obama although we have a very large christian population we do not consider ourselves a christian nation daryl c cornett the book s editor argues that america is partly christian a nation that was shaped by a blend of religious and non religious tendencies he writes after the civil war steady decline in religious adherence was the impetus for evangelicals to mythologize american history and pine for a return to a golden age of christian faith and virtue at its founding that never existed

september 11 the threat of terrorism remains etched into the inner workings of infrastructures through new laws regulations technologies and practices ellis maps these changes through an examination of three u s infrastructures the postal system the freight rail network and the electric power grid he describes for example how debates about protecting the mail from anthrax and other biological hazards spiraled into larger arguments over worker rights the power of large volume mailers and the fortunes of old media in a new media world how environmental activists leveraged post 9 11 security fears over shipments of hazardous materials to take on the rail industry and the chemical lobby and how otherwise marginal federal regulators parlayed new mandatory cybersecurity standards for the electric power industry into a robust system of accountability

this book presents the extraordinary story of a bolognese woman of the settecento laura maria caterina bassi 1711 1778 defended 49 theses at the university of bologna on april 17 1732 and was awarded a doctoral degree on may 12 of the same year three weeks before her defense she was made a member of the academy of sciences in bologna on june 27 she defended 12 additional theses several of the 61 theses were on physics and other science topics laura was drawn by the philosophy of newton at a time when most scientists in europe were still focused on descartes and galen this last set of theses was to encourage the university of bologna to provide a lectureship to laura which they did on october 29 1732 although quite famous in her day laura bassi is unfortunately not remembered much today this book presents bassi within the context of the century when she lived and worked an era where no women could attend university anywhere in the world and even less become a professor or a member of an academy laura was appointed to the chair of experimental physics in 1776 until her death her story is an amazing one laura was a mother a wife and a good scientist for over 30 years she made the transition from the old science to the new very early on in her career her work was centered on real problems that the city of bologna needed to solve it was an exciting time of discovery and she was at the edge of it all the way
